Now's the time to dispose of leftover hazardous waste materials. It's FREE, but for residential waste only.

AUTOMOTIVE & MARINE PRODUCTS- oil and fuel additives, grease and rust solvents, naval jelly, carburetor and fuel injector cleaners, starter fluids, body putty, antifreeze/coolant, gasoline

HOME MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS- used strippers and thinners, adhesives, driveway sealant, roofing tar, wallpaper remover

HOME GARDEN PRODUCTS- pesticides, fertilizers, wood preservatives

MISCELLANEOUS- pool chemicals, photo processing chemicals, aerosols/compressed gas, mercury thermostats and thermometers, fluorescent tubes, compact fluorescent bulbs and medicines/drugs (do not bring medicine in original bottles, instead empty medicine into plastic zip lock bags to bring to collection)

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: needles and sharps, infectious wastes, fireworks, gun powder, ammunition, radioactive materials such as smoke detectors and radium paint, empty containers of any kind, gas tanks, **paint and electronics**
